Internships renovation project Gruuthuse museum

Description

The Gruuthusemuseum is undergoing a complete renovation. The museum tells the city's (hi)stories, in which the museum's collection plays a very significant role. The collection consists of various types of decorative arts, from sculpture to hearth stones to tapestries and coins and medals. Some parts of the collection have been intensively investigated, while other parts have not.

Tasks:

Assisting with the collection research of the Gruuthusecollection consists of the following:

- Research: completing the research information of the objects used in the redecoration of the museum
- Passive conservation: preparing objects for display
- Assistance in depot and collection management
- Assistance of the assistant-curator collections/registrar of the Gruuthusemuseum

This collection consists of pieces from the last part of the fourteenth century till the twentieth century, among which the collection of Flemish primitives, Neo-classicism, and Flemish expressionism. The Groeningemuseum is also responsible for a varied program of exhibitions.

Tasks

The Groeningemuseum is looking for an intern for the startup of a few new old master exhibition projects. The intern assist the curator of the exhibition in drawing up the loan list, and updating the

files and collection registration of the selected objects. In addition, the intern participates in the daily tasks of the curator.
