Abbey Ten Putte

The picturesque Ten Putte abbey is located at the place where Godelieve van Gistel passed away in 1070. The young woman, who came from the area near what is now Boulogne-sur-Mer, was here rejected by her cruel husband and finally murdered. Very quickly tales of miracles started circulating and finally St. Godelieve was canonised in 1084. Around 1100 Ten Putte abbey, a Benedictine convent, was founded here. Currently the religious community Mother of Peace occupies the abbey, where you can still find many traces of Godelieve. The abbey has a large reception room with cafeteria. Saint Godelieve is invoked against eye and throat diseases... and in marriage problems.
